Sponsorship Information and Rules

- Small Duck race ticket stubs must be turned in to your Rotarian solicitor by Aug 22nd or bring to Chase Bank lobby, 200 E 7th St, Loveland, Saturday, Aug. 10th or Monday, Aug. 12th, between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm.
- Sponsors are <u>encouraged</u> to decorate one or more big ducks and enter them into a contest. Ribbons will be awarded for the **Best Dressed**, **Best Name**, **Most Creative**, **Best Theme** and **Best Duck Decorated** by a Student at various levels. Please note: We will not be racing Big Ducks.
- If you choose to decorate a duck, please read and follow the rules listed below.
 - ✓ Gorilla Glue should be used to fasten objects to your duck rather than a hot glue gun.
 - ✓ Any painted duck must not have a tacky surface that rubs off. Do not use enamel or petroleum-based paints. These paints do not cure. Craft or metal paint works best. Maximum dimensions are 3 ft.W, 1 ft H, 1 ft D. Be aware the ducks will be moved several times, causing possible loss or damage to fragile parts. Be sure all parts are well secured.
 - ✓ Please note: Rotary reserves the right to prevent the participation of any ducks inappropriately dressed or inappropriately named.
 - ✓ In order to enter your decorated duck(s) into the contest please bring it/them to the Chase Bank lobby at 200 East 7th Street, Loveland between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm, Saturday, Aug 10th, or between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm Monday, Aug. 12th. Please fill out the tag on the duck's neck completely and bring your completed race tickets to Chase bank with your decorated ducks.
 - ✓ Judging will begin August 13. The winners will be identified on the display at the Duck Race Booth of the Corn Roast Festival at Loveland Fairgrounds Park on August 23rd and 24th and listed on the Duck Race website, https://lovelandduckrace.com.
 - ✓ On Aug 24th, beginning at 3:00 pm, please pick up your decorated duck at the Corn Roast Festival, or ask your Rotary solicitor to return them to you.
